Bill Stevens has received performance and composition grants from the Seattle Arts Commission, Earshot Jazz, the American Music Center and the National Endowment for the Humanities and has spoken at the Norwegian Academy of Music in Oslo, Norway (2017) and the Australasian Jazz & Improvisation Research Network in Melbourne, Australia (2018). He regularly performs in New York City with ensembles under his own name.

Gary Fogel is a composer and percussionist who has been performing in the NYC area since 1980 as a side man and band leader. He has recorded on a number of albums and CDs as a band member and leader. Most recently he has been on the Music Faculty at the High School for Music and Performing Arts since 1995.
